



BABASHUVA – A New World. A New Reality: Educational Material for Divine Spiritual Humanism Based on the Bible and GOD

Short Introduction

Introduction: BABASHUVA offers a vision of a new world and a new reality through closeness to GOD, based on the principles of love, acceptance of all people, compassion, and kindness. We advocate for a return to the roots of the Jewish Bible and the observance of commandments according to the teachings of Moses, rather than according to human interpretations prevalent today.

1. Core Principles

a. Love: Love of God and love of fellow human beings are central principles in the Bible. **“Do not seek revenge or bear a grudge against anyone among your people, but love your neighbor as yourself. I am the Lord.” (Leviticus 19:18)** and **“Love the Lord your GOD with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your strength” (Deuteronomy 6:5)** serve as cornerstones of our initiative.

b. Acceptance of all people: The Bible emphasizes the value of every individual as a being created in the image of God. **“So God created mankind in his own image, in the image of God he created them; male and female he created them.” (Genesis 1:27).**

c. Compassion and Kindness: The Bible commands us to act with compassion and kindness towards others. **“God said to Moses, ‘I am who I am’. This is what you are to say to the**

Israelites: 'I am has sent me to you.' (Exodus 3:14) expresses the divine presence in every person.

2. Main Goals

a. Closeness to GOD: Through learning and observing the commandments according to the teachings of Moses, we aim to bring people closer to GOD and deepen their spiritual connection.

b. Strengthening moral values: We encourage the integration of biblical moral values such as justice, honesty, and selfless love.

c. Community Cooperation: Strengthening community spirit and brotherhood among all members, emphasizing principles of compassion and kindness.

3. Methods of Implementation

a. Torah Study: Conducting Torah classes and group discussions on biblical topics according to the Jewish Bible, to deepen understanding and connection with GOD.

b. Observance of Commandments: Encouraging the full observance of the commandments as given in the teachings of Moses, understanding this as the path to closeness with GOD.

c. Community Activities: Organizing volunteer activities and community events based on principles of love, compassion, and kindness.

4. Core Values

a. Love: As a supreme value that should guide all our actions - **"Do not seek revenge or bear a grudge against anyone among your people, but love your neighbor as yourself. I am the Lord."** (Leviticus 19:18) - as a central commandment in life.

b. Compassion: The ability to feel and understand the suffering of others and to help them.

c. Kindness: Performing good deeds for others out of generosity.

5. Practical Examples from the Bible

Abraham: Abraham is an example of the ability to accept different people and treat them with love and kindness, as seen in his hospitality to guests, making efforts to honor and care for them. **"1 The Lord appeared to Abraham near the great trees of Mamre while he was sitting at the entrance to his tent in the heat of the day. 2 Abraham looked up and saw three men standing nearby. When he saw them, he hurried from the entrance of his tent to meet them and bowed low to the ground. 3 He said, "If I have found favor in your eyes, my lord, do not pass your servant by. 4 Let a little water be brought, and then you may all wash your feet and rest under this tree. 5 Let me get you something to eat, so you can be**

refreshed and then go on your way—now that you have come to your servant.” “Very well,” they answered, “do as you say.” (Genesis 18, 1-5)

Moses: Moses as a leader who connects the people to GOD and leads them on a path of justice and compassion, caring for the well-being of each individual. **"Afterward Moses and Aaron went to Pharaoh and said, “This is what the Lord, the God of Israel, says: ‘Let my people go, so that they may hold a festival to me in the wilderness’". (Exodus 5:1)**

Rebecca: Rebecca stands out for her kindness and compassion when she gives water to Eliezer, Abraham's servant, and his camels. **"15 Before he had finished praying, Rebekah came out with her jar on her shoulder. She was the daughter of Bethuel son of Milkah, who was the wife of Abraham’s brother Nahor. 16 The woman was very beautiful, a virgin; no man had ever slept with her. She went down to the spring, filled her jar and came up again. 17 The servant hurried to meet her and said, “Please give me a little water from your jar.” 18 “Drink, my lord,” she said, and quickly lowered the jar to her hands and gave him a drink. 19 After she had given him a drink, she said, “I’ll draw water for your camels too, until they have had enough to drink.” 20 So she quickly emptied her jar into the trough, ran back to the well to draw more water, and drew enough for all his camels. 21 Without saying a word, the man watched her closely to learn whether or not the Lord had made his journey successful." (Genesis 24, 15-21).**

6. Vision for the Future

a. Spiritual and moral community: Creating a community guided by biblical principles, striving for a life of mutual respect, love, compassion, and kindness.

b. Spiritual development: Encouraging all community members to pursue spiritual and moral development through Torah study, observance of commandments, and positive community activities.

c. Peace and harmony: Creating a new reality where all people live in peace and harmony with themselves and their environment, observing the commandments of the Torah as a way of life.
